Operations Department

Clean Water Act - All Buildings and ECH

In 2023, Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) implemented a new School Water Drinking Program to develop a Drinking Water Management Plan, install lead reducing filters and test filtered water. To be compliant, we installed new bottle filling stations and undersink filtration systems in all buildings. Regarding the testing of water, ARCH Environmental has been testing the drinking water for many years at Wyandotte Public Schools.

RHS - 6 new bottle filling stations, 8 undersink filtration stations

WMS - 9 new bottle filling stations, 9 undersink filtration stations

ECH - 4 new bottle filling stations, 1 undersink filtration stations

Garfield - 2 new bottle filling stations, 2 undersink filtration stations

Washington - 1 new bottle filling stations, 4 undersink filtration stations

Monroe - 5 undersink filtration stations

Jefferson - 4 new bottle filling stations, 2 undersink filtration stations

Jb/Madison - 3 new bottle filling stations, 5 undersink filtration stations

TLC - 1 new bottle filling stations, 5 undersink filtration stations

Energy Audit

We worked with the Synergy Consulting Engineers to perform an energy audit on all buildings as required by the State of Michigan. This work was performed throughout the summer and completed on August 8, 2025.
