1. **Chromebooks-**Technology Services proposes the purchase of 149 Special Education student Chromebooks for use at Jo Brighton, Madison, and The Lincoln Center from Sehi Computers at an approximate cost of \$57,037.20, if purchased before Dec. 12. After Dec. 12, the cost will increase by \$4,172 for the Chromebooks. Cases may also increase. We are seeing rapid and unpredictable cost increases in the last several months. Federal ACT 18 funds will be used for the purchase. However, the total budget approved cannot increase (\$58,272,60). Therefore, any increase will reduce the number of Chromebooks purchased.
